



ADVANCED BUSINESS CERTIFICATE (ABC) HEALTH CARE FINANCE AND INSURANCE

The **Programs in Healthcare Management & Insurance Studies** offers an Advanced Business Certificate for business professionals who are interested in careers in the area of health care economics, finance and insurance. Principles of economics, finance and insurance are stressed. These business skills are essential for understanding the complex and rapidly changing health care industry in which medical care organizations, including consulting firms, hospitals, health plans, pharmaceutical companies, long-term care facilities, physician practice management firms and others, operate. These courses focus on an understanding of the economic and financial environment in which medical care organizations operate. They also explore the institutional framework and regulatory environment faced by medical care organizations and provide conceptual models and analytical tools for better understanding the behavior and performance of real-world medical care firms.

Eligibility and Application Process

To qualify for admission to the ABC – Health Care Finance and Insurance program, an applicant must have a graduate degree (Ph.D., MD, JD, Master's) from an accredited institution OR an undergraduate degree from an accredited institution and be working in the area of health care finance and insurance.
