

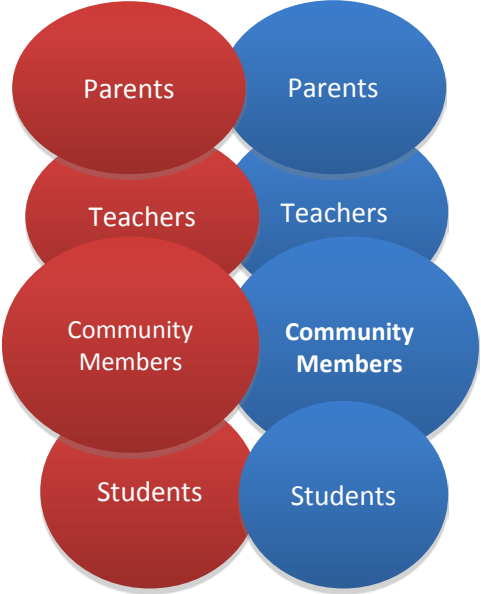

The purpose of the Steering Committee is to serve as a “filter” for all of the cadre inquiry work being conducted. It serves as a collaborative support team for all of the school’s happenings and provides a sound communication forum for clear and open dialogue. Steering is representative of all cadre facilitators, parents, community, staff, students and administrators.



The intent of council is to enable parents, school staff, students (where appropriate) and community leaders to work together to improve student achievement in the state’s lowest performing schools. School Governance Councils serve in an advisory capacity to assist the school administration.



Tasks: Coordinate and filter cadre work; Support the inquiry structure; model consensus based decision-making

Tasks: Analyze achievement data, review the fiscal objectives of the school's draft budget and advise the principal before the budget is submitted to the superintendent, participate in the hiring process of the principal or other administrators, assist the principal in making programmatic and operational changes to improve the school’s achievement, develop and approve a written school parent involvement policy that outlines the roles of parents and guardians.
