Requested Revisions: Must fill in section 41f of CAR and offer more specifics on the writing process for thesis writers.

• EKIN 3547W Service Learning Through Sport and Physical Activity

- CSE 2300W Digital Logic Design
- CSE 4939W Computer Science and Engineering Design Project I

The W Subcommittee recommends approving the following course proposal revisions for the W competency contingent upon revisions as requested:

• LAMS 1190W Introduction to Latin America and the Caribbean

Requested Revisions: The syllabus should include the "F Clause" (some version of this should be on all W syllabi): "In order to pass this course, you must receive a passing grade on its writing components." On the CAR box 41f, a required section, was left blank. Under "W Course" you must explain how the W requirements will be met. This is evident in the syllabus, but the CAR is the document serves as the archived record for the course, so the "W" section (41f) must include a summary of what the syllabus promises about writing.
