


### University Student Population




#### Number of Individual Referrals and Total Incidents By Month for 2012-2013




#### Number of Total Incidents By Month: Two Year Comparision






#### Number of Individual Referrals By Month: Two Year Comparision






Gender Percentage: 2012-2013




Gender Percentage: Fall 2012



Gender Percentage: Spring 2013





**Expulsions – 2012 - 2013**

Eighteen male students and one female student were expelled for the following types of circumstances (Ten of the students had student conduct history):

- Assault (one student)
- Driving under the influence of alcohol and striking a pedestrian (two students)
- Drug distribution (twelve students)
- Possession of drugs while on University Probation (one student)
- Sexual misconduct (two students)
- Major theft (one student)

**University Probation**

111 students appeared before the Probation Review Committee in 2012-2013. 106 students (95%) were successful and their University Probations were lifted. 5 students were denied (5%).
